

GET OUT FOR A WALK

Genesee Valley Greenway or
Finger Lakes Trail

~ wonderful woods in NO HUNTING zones ~

Enjoy miles of deep woods and river gorge views from park lands surrounding the Visitor Center at the Mt. Morris Dam within Letchworth State Park. This area is closed to hunting, both archery and guns, so for those who wish they had somewhere to walk from mid-October to mid-December, here is a safe place! Come sample the trails going in both directions from the Dam. Local maps available in foyer of Visitor Center. Or for a guided walk, check out the schedule below.

All walks meet first at the Dam Visitor Center, two miles down the clearly signed turn-off from NY 408 south of Mt. Morris. Dress appropriately for weather and bring water!

16 November, Friday 9:00 AM	Leader Sharon Galbraith	Minimum 4 miles out and back from dam through oak forest to Greenway. Option to add more, looping through county park.
18 November, Sunday 1:00 PM	Leader Irene Szabo	Easy two-mile walk from dam to Hogsback Overlook
23 November, Friday 10:00 AM	Leader Irene Szabo	Walk off your Thanksgiving feast exploring the incredible variety of trees growing in woods and old fields between dam and village.
2 December, Sunday 10:00 AM	Repeat of 16 November.	Bring lunch!
