

Volunteer Opportunities

The Finger Lakes Trail was built and is maintained by **VOLUNTEERS**. Each year volunteers log in approximately 15,000 hours of trail work, but trail work alone does not keep the organization going. There are many other things that must be done to support the trail and provide services to our members, our partners, and the general public. We hope that **YOU** will consider volunteering some of your time and talents to the FLTC. Listed below are some things to consider, and to check if you're interested. Because of limited space, some of the items listed are without much detail, so feel free to ask for more information before volunteering.

- occasional trail work projects
- as a trail caretaker. Love your own piece of trail to death!
- with volunteer projects at the Service Center in Mt. Morris (mailings, inventory, filing etc.) Service Center tasks are typically done during the day on Mondays or Thursdays.
- as a phone caller on behalf of the FLT (ideally you have free long distance calling) Phone callers will help check information, greet new members, make reminder calls, etc.
- as a member of our publicity/promotions team helping to keep promotional materials available in strategic locations (mostly along the trail corridor) and/or follow up with publicity efforts.
- assist us as we update our guidebooks (could be fieldwork and/or clerical)
- technology advisor for the office staff (help us streamline tasks on a strict budget)
- with committee work (if at all interested, we'll send you a committee list)
- serve on the Board of Managers (our governing body)
- lead short walks in the area near the Mt. Morris Dam in conjunction with the programs being co-sponsored with the Corps of Engineers, Greenway, Audubon Society, etc.
- serve as a "car spotter/trail angel" (ask for details)
